CALT Fact Sheet

The mission of Central Arizona Land Trust (CALT) is to conserve and protect Arizona's open space, wildlife habitat, working agricultural lands, and scenic and cultural values for future generations. CALT is a nationally accredited land trust, located in Prescott, Arizona. Founded in 1989, the IRS considers CALT qualified to hold perpetual conservation easements, in partnership with land owners on a variety of vanishing landscapes such as wildlife habitat, working farms and ranches, riparian areas, open space, scenic viewsheds, and historic sites. Today CALT holds conservation easements on more than 7,000 acres in Yavapai, Coconino and Maricopa counties.

Each year, CALT hosts the "Wide Open Spaces Celebration" to honor local land owners who have chosen to permanently protect their family land with conservation easements as well as volunteers who have contributed "sweat equity" to enhance conservation efforts. Past honorees have been the Orme family for Orme Ranch, the Pierce family for Bar Triangle Ranch, the City of Prescott's Over the Hill Gang for thousands of hours of trail building and maintenance, and the Granite Dells Preservation Foundation for a trail dedication on the Peavine Trail system.

CALT Board Members are approaching sponsors for the 2026 Wide Open Spaces Celebration with opportunities to provide support for this event, which will host 80-100 attendees from throughout the state.
